Welcome to our series, What Can I Do? Now a lot of times, when we're thinking about what we can do, we tend to think about what we might do when we grow up, but guess what? • INSTRUCTIONS: Introduce this months memory verse and explain its meaning.

Key points about this verse:

Context:

Paul wrote this verse while imprisoned, demonstrating his ability to find peace and contentment despite his difficult situation.

• Focus on God's strength:

The verse emphasizes that the strength to overcome challenges comes from Christ, not from oneself.

• Not about personal achievement:

It doesn't mean you can accomplish anything you set your mind to without limitations, but rather that you can face life's difficulties with God's support.

SO WHAT? Why does it matter to God and to us?

SCRIPTURE | Mark 1:4-11 (Jesus and John the Baptist) - Karla/Rachel

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** Each week for the Bible story section, invite a professional to talk to kids as a mini Career Day interview. Have them share a little about what they do (bonus points if they bring visual aids!) and help you tell the Bible Story, too. This week, consider bringing in a dancer, singer, musician, worship leader, or someone else with a background in performing arts. If you cannot find somebody to invite, use the suggested script below and show a video of any professional performer (like a <u>ballet dancer</u> or an <u>opera singer</u>). For more information on how to legally use copyrighted material for educational purposes, <u>read this!</u>
 - ACCESSIBILITY HACK: This series is a great opportunity to normalize disabilities for kids. Show this video of a dancer who uses a wheelchair (or something similar), not to discuss their challenges but to show the diversity of people and careers.
- Hey everyone, welcome to the *What Can I Do?* Career Day! Each week, we are going to learn about a cool profession out there that might be interesting to you. Then we'll talk about how it relates to a story about Jesus!
- (share about your job and how listening is important to what you do. Who are the people or rules you have to pay attention to?)
 - All of this reminds me of our Bible story for today where listening is key.
 Let's check it out in Mark 1:4-11. (have kids look this up in thier bibles)

- John the Baptist was given a very important job before he was even born! He was
 going to tell everyone he met that a savior was coming to save them from their
 sins. Sin is all the stuff we do that gets in the way of having a loving relationship
 with God.
- John's life was very different from others I'm sure some people even thought he was strange. But his main focus was on doing what God had planned for him to do. Instead of paying attention to what anyone else said, he listened to God's voice and did his job of preparing people for Jesus.
- He baptized people in the river to help them understand that living a new life with God meant their old lives were "washed away" in the water. Then one day, Jesus himself showed up to be baptized by John! When Jesus came up out of the water, God's voice could be heard saying that Jesus was indeed God's son and God was very pleased with him.
- John knew that he had been doing the right job all along. Because of what he heard from God, he continued to tell others about God's son, Jesus, who came to be the savior of the world.

- SCRIPTURE QUESTIONS
 - Who was sent to prepare the way for Jesus? (John the Baptist.)
 - Why did Jesus come to see John? (To be baptized.)
 - What did God's voice say when Jesus was baptized? ("You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased.")
- APPLICATION QUESTIONS
 - What does it mean to listen to God's voice?
 - What are some ways that God speaks?

PRAYER

Ask for prayer requests and write prayer requests on a prayer card. Then pray together
