STORY TIME

BIG IDEA | I can trust Jesus knows me.- Loren

- INSTRUCTIONS:
- What can I do? Today's Big Idea says . . . I can trust Jesus knows me!
 - ∘ **I** (Point to self.)
 - Trust (Prayer hands.)
 - Jesus (Point to sky.)
 - Knows me (Place hands on heart.)

SCRIPTURE | John 1:43-51 (Jesus Calls Phillip and Nathanael) - Kat/Melissa

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** Prepare props like stethoscopes, reflex hammers, bandages, and toy syringes to decorate your space and allow kids to play with.
- Where do you go when you are feeling sick? Who are the people who help you?

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- People like doctors, nurses, dentists, and emergency workers take care of all different kinds of sicknesses and pains. They have to get to know us to help us feel better.
- Let's pretend you're getting a check-up!
- **First, let's check your eyes.** Follow my finger with your eyes as I move it side to side.
- Now, let's check your hearing. Close your eyes. Can you hear me clapping my hands?
- **Next, let's check your heartbeat.** Make heart sounds with me ba bump . . . ba bump . . . ba bump.
- And how about your teeth? Everyone smile really wide!
- In the Bible, in John chapter 1, we see that Jesus knows us even better than doctors do.
- Jesus was starting to do God's work and he invited some people to join him. One of those people was Phillip. Phillip was so excited to meet Jesus that he went to go tell his friend Nathanael all about it.
- Nathanael didn't really want to go with Phillip to meet Jesus at first. But Phillip told him that Jesus was the savior everyone had been waiting for.
- When Nathanael finally met Jesus, he was so surprised at how well Jesus knew him! Jesus knew that Nathanael was a good guy and Jesus also knew Nathanael had been resting under a fig tree.
- That was when Nathanael knew he could trust Jesus. That's why he chose to follow Jesus, too!

PLAY TIME

ACTIVITY | Coloring Page

• **INSTRUCTIONS:** Print and distribute the <u>coloring page</u> along with crayons or markers. As the kids color, you can review today's Bible story, Big Idea, and memory verse.

Discuss with kids as they color about the bible story, memory verse and big idea.

Remember, repetition is key:)

ACTIVITY | Where Does It Hurt?

Loren- Gather all the kids on the rug after small groups, after everyone have Aislin lead the activity

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** On butcher paper, draw an outline of a person you can ask one of the kids to lie down on the paper and trace them. Make red marks on the outline to represent ouchies. Kids will take turns running down to the butcher paper and putting their Band-Aid on one of the injuries to make the person better. Continue play until all of the injuries are better.
- Sometimes, we get hurt. We might fall down and bump our knee, or we might get a cut on our finger. If we have to go to the hospital, they might take our temperature, measure our height, listen to our heartbeat, or even take an x-ray to learn more about us and find the best way to help us.
- Jesus doesn't need to do any of that. Jesus knows everything about us. Not just the hurts on our bodies but even the hurts in our hearts. Sometimes we might feel sad

or mad or hurt. Jesus knows and he cares about us.
