**ACTIVITY | Puzzle Plans** 

#### **CHECK IN:** Andrew S.

Greet each preschooler animatedly as they arrive and help them feel welcome and secure. Parents will feel more assured leaving their little ones, and it will help preschoolers to connect with you.

#### **ACTIVITY:** Kat/Melissa

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** Have preschoolers work together to put together a giant construction-themed floor puzzle. Alternatively, you can print out pictures of construction vehicles, cut them into six to eight pieces, and place them in individual baggies for kids to put together independently.
  - **TODDLER HACK:** Use shape-sorting chunky puzzles (like this) that are easier to grab and match for toddlers. Allow them to play with the pieces as toys also. Puzzles are a toddler favorite as they are starting to develop their problem-solving skills. A puzzle can be anything that requires them to sort or put things together. You can create simple puzzles for toddlers by cutting a simple picture into three parts or making a hole in a box to stick things into.
- A puzzle follows a clear plan. Every piece has a place where it belongs and that's
  what makes the big picture come together. What happens when you try to
  put a piece where it doesn't go? If you put the pieces in the wrong place, the
  picture would be very different!
- Today we are going to talk about how God has a plan for all of us. We can trust God's plans because God sees the big picture.

### STORY TIME

BIG IDEA | I can trust God's plans for me. - Andrew

- INSTRUCTIONS: Introduce this weeks big idea
- What can I do? Today's Big Idea says . . . I can be sure Jesus knows me!
  - ∘ I (Point to self.)
  - Can trust (Clasp hands together.)
  - God's (Point to sky.)
  - Plans for me (Hold out hands like a book.)

SCRIPTURE | Mark 1:14–20 (Jesus Calls Andrew, Peter, James, and John)- Kat/Melissa

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** Prepare props like hard hats, safety goggles, and toy tools to decorate your space and allow kids to play with.
- What do you call people who make buildings, bridges, and houses? Builders or construction workers!
  - People who work in construction have to follow the plans they've been given.
     They trust those plans to help them make tall buildings, bridges, churches, and the homes we live in.
  - Let's pretend we are on a construction site.
  - Safety first! Pretend to put on your hard hats and your safety goggles.
  - Can you name what kinds of construction vehicles you would see?
     Excavators, diggers, tractors, bulldozers, rollers, dump trucks.
  - Let's pretend to use a hammer. Tap one of your fists with your other fist.
  - **Now let's saw a piece of wood.** Hold out one hand and slide the side of your hand on top back and forth.
  - **Now let's drill into the ground with a jackhammer!** Put your hands out in front of you (like you're holding a scooter) and jump around really fast!
- In the Bible, in Mark chapter 1, Jesus showed a group of people that God had plans for them . . . but they were different from building plans.
- There were four people: Simon, Andrew, James, and John. They were fishers. Their job was to go out every day to catch fish that they could sell or eat.

- Jesus came and gave them a new job. He told them to stop fishing because he had better plans for them. He told them instead of fishing for fish, they could follow Jesus and help him fish for people.
  - Fish for people? What do you think that means?
  - It meant that Simon, Andrew, James, and John would go tell other people to follow Jesus.
- When Jesus told them to follow him, they left everything and followed him right away! That's because they trusted God's plans for them.

**ACTIVITY | Build A Building** 

# Andrew S.- Gather all the kids on the rug after small groups, after everyone is ready have Leila lead the game

- **INSTRUCTIONS:** Give preschoolers ten cardboard blocks or plastic cups. Have kids work together to build a tall tower. If working with cups, show them how to build a foundation and stack the cups so they don't fall.
- Builders use plans to build things. Plans help them know what they're working on. Without a plan, you wouldn't know how tall a building has to be, how many rooms to build, where to put doors or stairs . . . you wouldn't even know what you were building!
- In today's Bible story, we'll see that there were four people who had a solid plan about what they would do for the rest of their lives. But God's plans were better!
